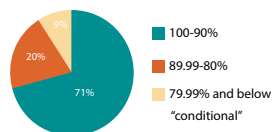

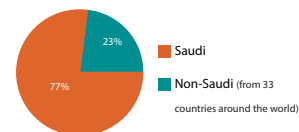

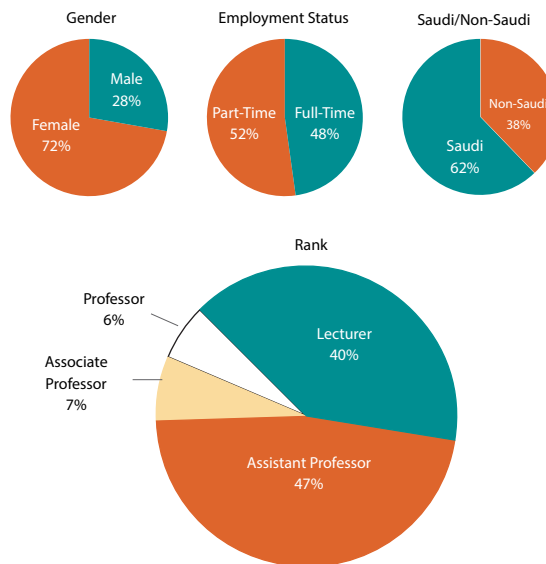

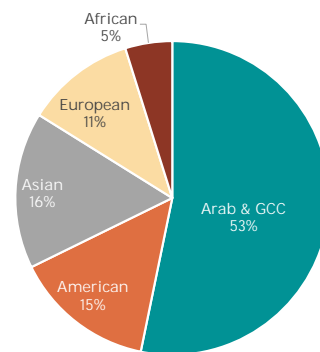
- Total DAH alumni is: 4,111

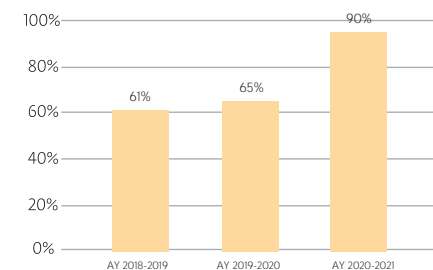
